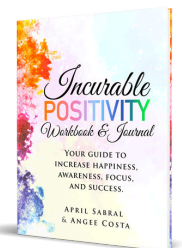
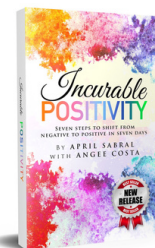
Mission
